We look forward to seeing you all again on Monday after a wonderful weekend.

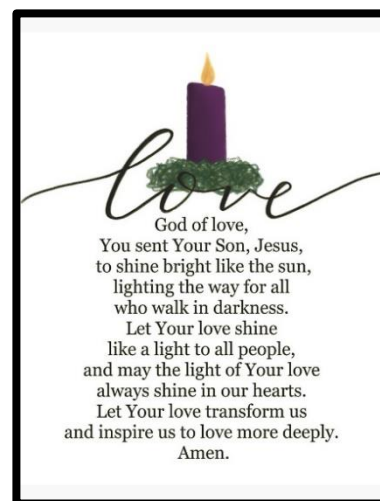





## St James PTFA

- Have you ever noticed a small act of kindness make a big difference in someone's day? What was the act?

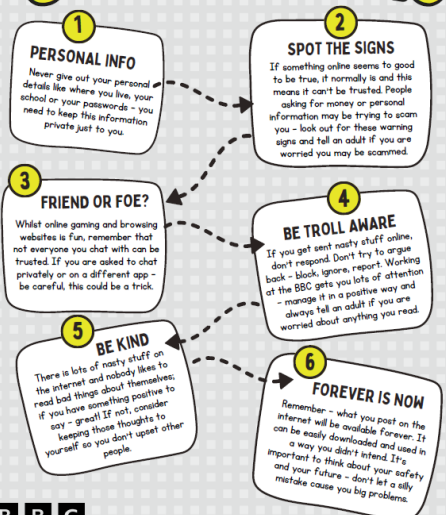
